Due to the hotel advance food ordering requirement, the **deadline to receive your registration is Aug. 12.**

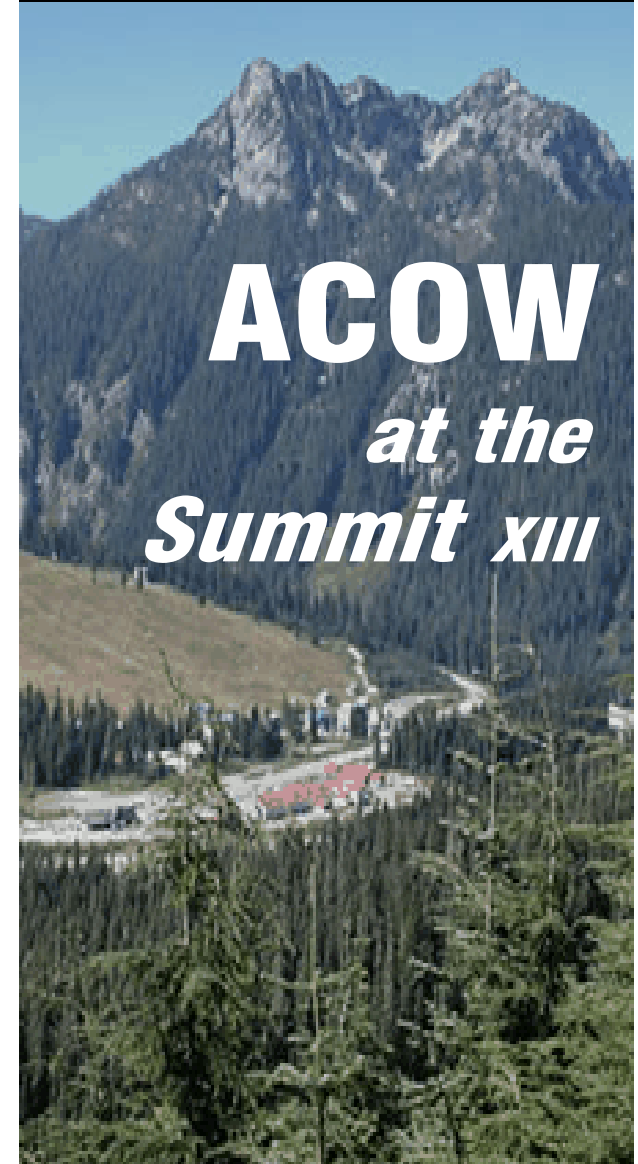
